PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Indian Residential School project was created to focus on the search for unmarked graves at Blue Quills University- St. Paul site, a former Indian Residential School.

The University is working collaboratively with a Indigenous led search team from the University of Alberta to conduct phase one of the ground search. The report for the results will be shared in the Spring of 2023 and decisions based on findings will involve Survivors as well as families of missing children.
