HEALTH CARE AIDE PROGRAM

Beginning September 2023

(Pending enrollment)

Academic requirements:

-minimum of English Language Arts 20-2 (or provincial equivalent), or successful completion of an academic assessment.

Non-Academic Requirements

- Personal Statement
- Immunization record
- Criminal record check

Must have the ability to perform physical tasks related to duties

All students will be required to complete in-class instruction, and practicum placement.

If you want a rewarding career that offers employment and job satisfaction, then the Health Care Aide program is suitable for you. This program will blend Indigenous thought and ways of being into the traditional Health Care Aide curriculum.

Health Care Aides are frontline workers providing basic health services and daily living activities service directly to the client. It is important that you are physically fit as working with physically impaired clients is part of the job.

This program will teach you how to communicate and work effectively with the health care team, clients and family. This program will support you in providing care and an understanding of the function of the human body in relation to holistic, ethical, safe patient care in various life stages. It will prepare you to write the provincial exam to become certified as a Health Care Aide.
